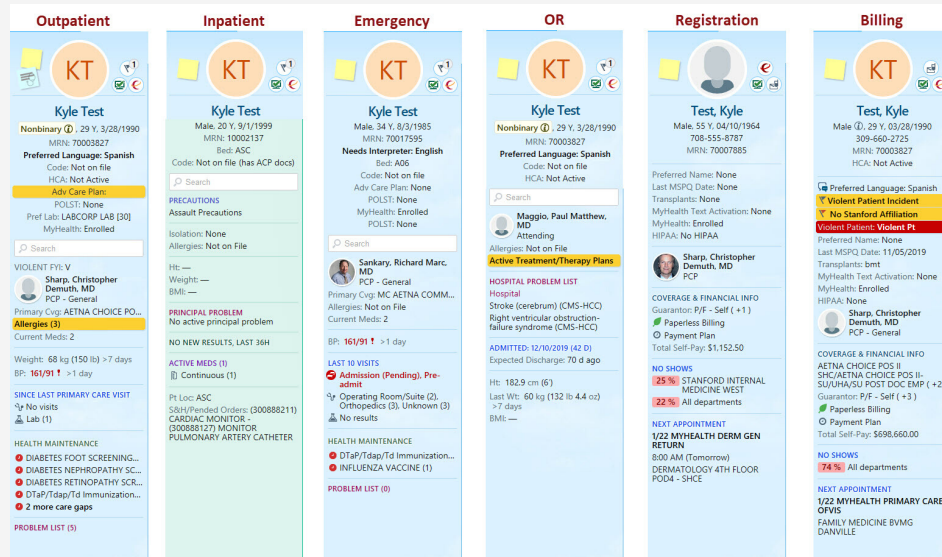


STORYBOARD COMING FEB 1



Storyboard is the new way to quickly view information about your patients within Epic. The Epic design will be available to most users across Stanford Health Care, University Healthcare Alliance, and ValleyCare on **February 1**, with the option to toggle the feature on and off. Storyboard replaces the “patient banner” on the top of the screen.

What's New?

Pertinent patient details will now be available on the left side of a patient’s chart with the ability to see the data as you move across the Storyboard (“hover to discover”). Information displayed in Storyboard will include, but not be limited to:

How Do I Enable Storyboard?

Enable Storyboard from any patient chart:

1. Click **Customize** in the lower left of the **Activity Tabs**
2. Click **Move Tabs to Top**

When Will Storyboard Be Fully Implemented?

February 1: Option to enable Storyboard and turn it on and off via the toggle feature

March 16: Storyboard will be visible automatically at login with the ability to toggle to the previous view

April 18: Storyboard will be the only option for viewing patient records in Epic for all users
